GDHP "Policy Environments Workstream" aims to integrate digital technologies into policy frameworks

- > **Goal:** to ensure that advancements and insights are rapidly disseminated and applied to improve healthcare outcomes worldwide

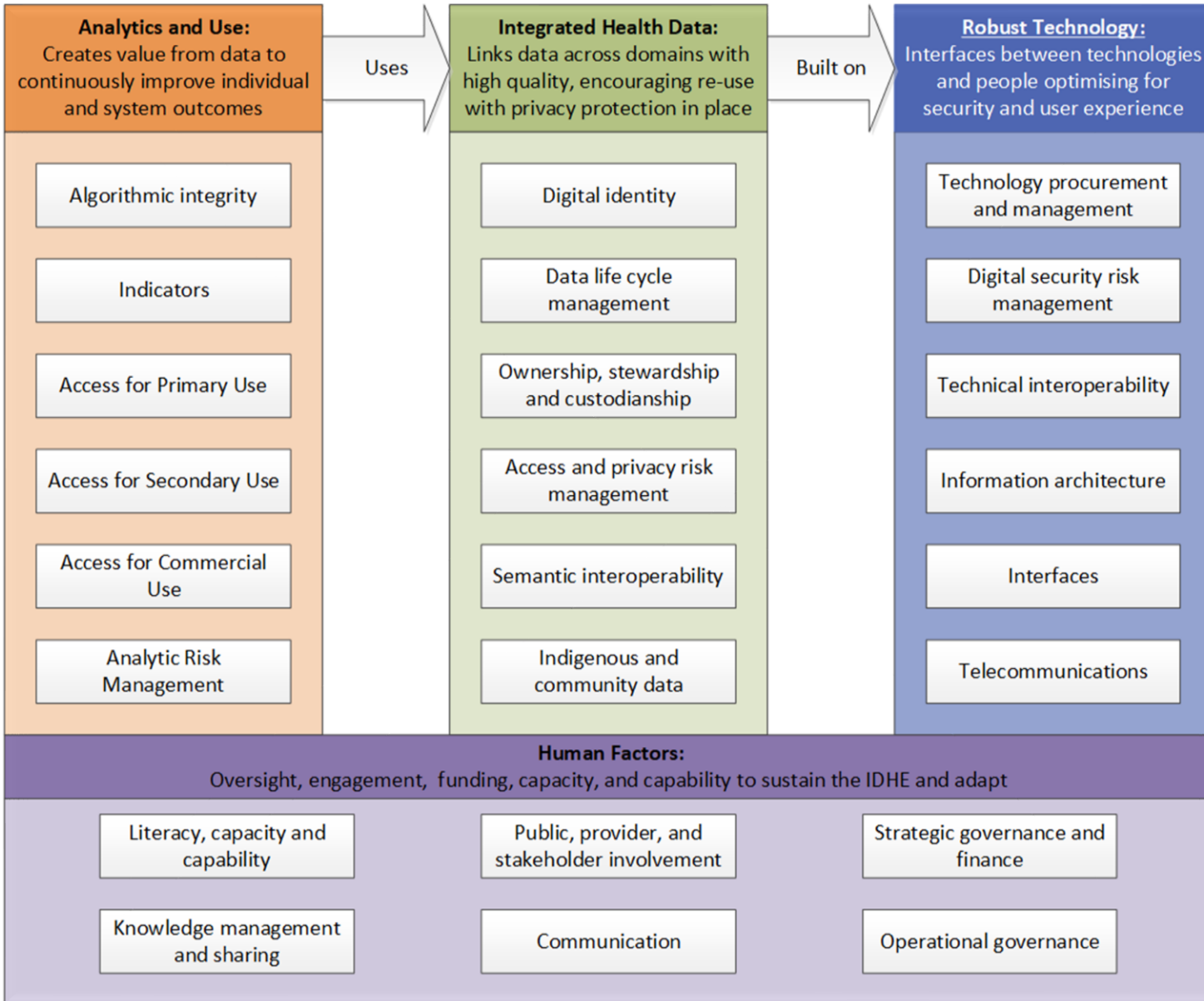


OECD-GDHP Policy Repository Tool

- > **Goal:** to map an international digital health policy repository to the key functions and policy areas covered by countries, to better compare and discuss approaches and policy language / framing



OECD Policy Checklist as a foundation for the OECD-GDHP Policy Repository Tool



Overarching areas of the Policy Checklist

- > Analytics and Use
- > Integrated Health Data
- > Robust Technology
- > Human Factors

- > Includes 24 policy areas as elements of digital health policy
- > Provides an ‘heatmap’ of the policy coverage of GDHP countries – informing about countries gaps in digital health policy areas

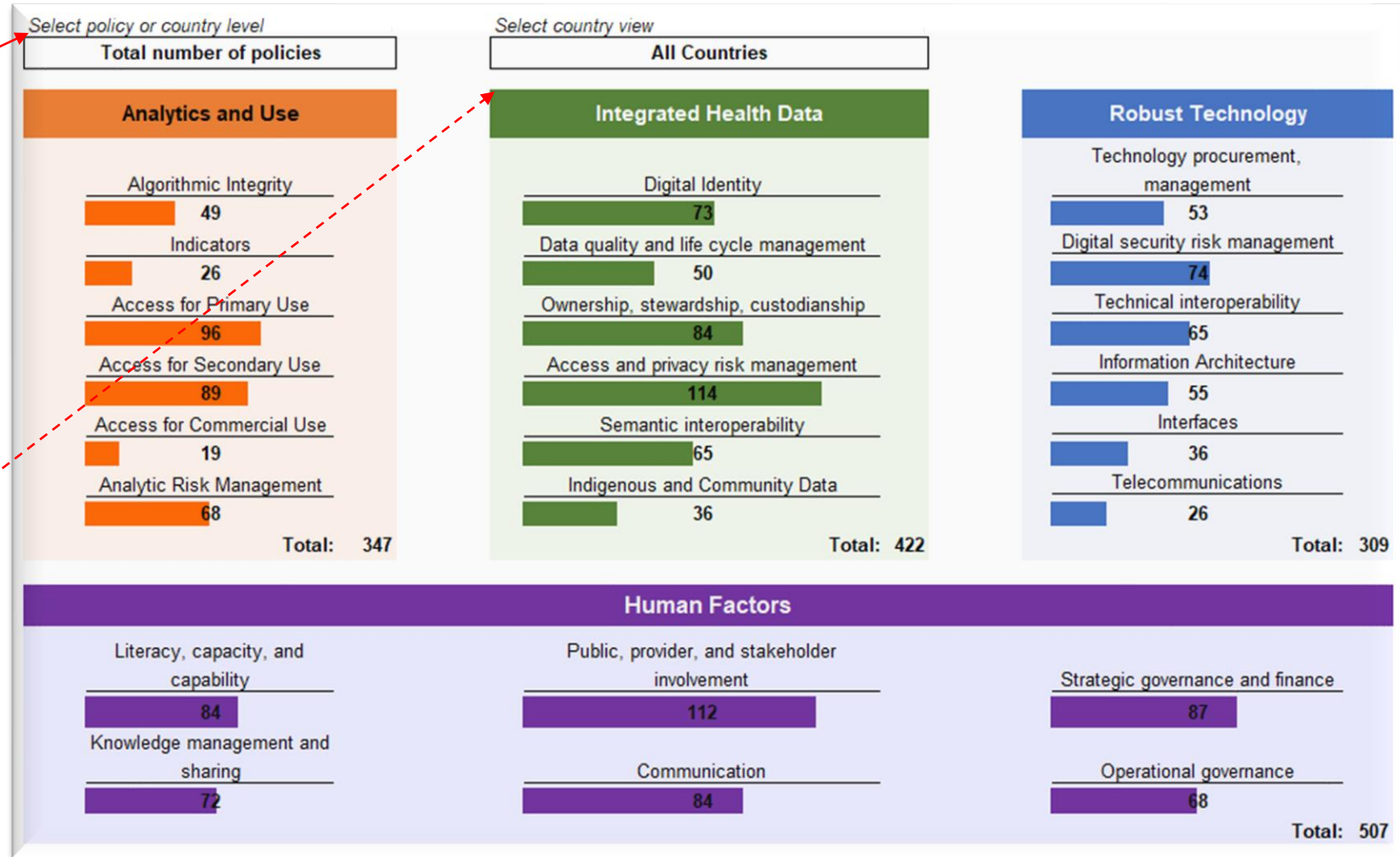


The Policy Dashboard contains the 'heatmap view' of the policy elements covered by a country or the entire GDHP country members

Toggle to view either:

1. Total count of policies in the database; or,
2. Whether or not there is a policy in that area

Toggle to select either an individual country or the total of all policies in the database, *All GDHP Countries*





User Guide 2: Country Sheets

Each country has their own sheet which can be used to both **input** and **view** their policy data. In the input section, there are a few areas of action.

1. **Type:** To select if the document included is a **Policy, Strategy, Implementation Guide, or Case-Study / Solution**
2. **Document Title:** The title of the document or policy. There are several ‘themes’ (e.g. Health Data Use and Exchange) under which different policies can be placed, however, these are **non-consequential and more to aid the user**
3. **Document Link:** Please include the direct link to the document or policy – these will be **used directly in the dashboard**
4. **Policy Checklist Mappings:** Input areas for the most relevant policy elements. Write “X” under the qualifying policy elements. These are abbreviated titles. Full definitions of the policy areas can be found in the Policy Checklist Reference Document

User Guide 3: Country Sheets – Dashboard



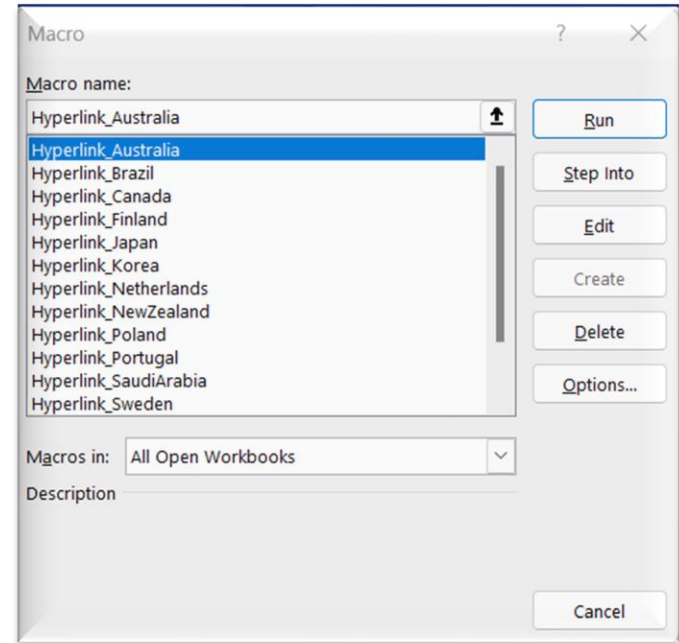
The *Country Sheet Dashboard* (D5:Q108) displays the number of policies for this country across the Policy Checklist

Note: there is no user input in this area

The Dashboard will automatically populate the relevant policy titles and active links to the source site / documentation.

Toggle the groupings to the left of Column A to expand the view

Troubleshooting: if the links are not updated in the Country Sheet Dashboard, navigate to the top Ribbon to *View* → *Macros* → *View Macros* → ‘*Run*’ the Macro for the relevant country
